INTERNET ACCESS

- **ISUguest** or **IASTATE** are wireless networks available to campus visitors.

PUNCTUALITY

Being on-time to your scheduled campaign sessions is **pivotal** to this event. Please try to be ready at the location of your table **at least five minutes prior** to the scheduled start time. If you're playing in a session that starts at 9 AM, you should be waiting outside the table room at 8:55 *at the latest*. Your GM can let you know if you're able to enter the room ahead of time, but no aspect of the campaign should begin until the scheduled start time.

BREAKS

Between each campaign session there is a **one-hour break period** that participants are free to spend however they'd like. However, be respectful of the teardown process for GMs who just finished their campaigns and the setup process for upcoming GMs. In addition, if you leave the building during the breaks, be sure to give yourself time to return with plenty of time to spare before your next scheduled campaign session.

BUILDING ACCESS

- The main entrances of the building will be unlocked from 8 AM - 10 PM daily. After 10 PM, you will need an access card (*provided to everyone staying on-site*) to re-enter the building.
- **Elevator Access:** While Tables 3-7 will be located on the ground floor, Tables 1 & 2 will be located on the **Third Floor**. To access the Third Floor via the elevator, **you will need to use an access card** (*provided to everyone staying on-site*). If you are not staying on-site, please coordinate with someone who is (or a member of the admin staff) to provide you access to the Third Floor for any sessions scheduled at Tables 1 & 2.
- Attendees should remain only on the **Ground floor** and the **3rd floor** of the building. Another small group of students is currently occupying the 7th floor – *so be respectful*.

IMPORTANT POLICIES

- **Alcohol Policy**
 - Treat this event just like the dorms in college! Alcohol consumption is **strictly forbidden** in any-and-all **public spaces** (hallways, main hall, gaming rooms, elevators, etc). We also don't want to see any alcohol containers **entering / exiting the building** - or left behind in any **waste bins**.
 - All attendees are expected to **help enforce** this important aspect of the event.
 - *However*, what happens behind the closed doors of your room or what is contained within **sealed, opaque** containers in public spaces is **none of our business**.. *We may or may not be offering cool new **Osiris tumblers** - perfect for such consumption.*
- **Conduct Policy**
 - We are a club of adults gathered for mutual recreation. We expect all members to be **respectful** of the facility, the staff, and each other and act with the **maturity** and **sportsmanship**.

CHECK-IN PROCESS

- Check-in will begin on Friday at **5 PM** and continue through the start of the Opening Ceremony at **8:30 PM**. Upon arrival, enter the main entrance on the south side of the building and check-in at the welcome table. You'll receive your attendee badge, a schedule and map of the event space, and for overnight guests your room key and access card.

EARLY / LATE CHECK-IN

- Early and late check-in is available upon request - just call or text **Austin** (319-202-4058) and/or **Josh** (563-249-6775) to let them know when to expect you. We'll be on-site at Geoffroy on Friday beginning setup by 9 AM so anyone interested in joining to help us midday is certainly welcome.

FOR OVERNIGHT GUESTS

- **Linens & Bathrooms:** A linen packet will be provided for each participant, including sheets, pillow, pillowcase, blanket, two towels, and one washcloth. You'll need to bring your own toiletries and bathroom products.
- **Rooms:** Each overnight guest will have their room located on the Third Floor of the building. Your room number will be provided to you upon arrival. Men's rooms will be in the House on the left side of the elevator and women's rooms will be in the House to the right. Each room has its own climate control settings.
- **Third Floor Bathrooms:** Geoffroy Hall has group-style (community-style) bathrooms in the residence areas with multiple sinks, toilets, and partitioned showers with private changing areas. There is a designated Men's Bathroom and Women's bathroom in both of the Houses on the floor. You will need your access card to enter these bathrooms.
- **Public bathrooms** are also available on the Ground floor.
- **Keys:** You'll be provided a key packet containing your room key and a keycard to access the building's exterior doors. If a key is lost, contact Osiris staff to arrange for a replacement with ISU. Replacement key costs are: \$122 for each key, \$10 for each keycard, and \$3 for each key packet.



CHECK-OUT

When you are ready to check out at the end of the event, make sure you've collected all of your belongings from your room and drop your key packet off at the table in the main hall. Staff will collect all the keys and return them to ISU.

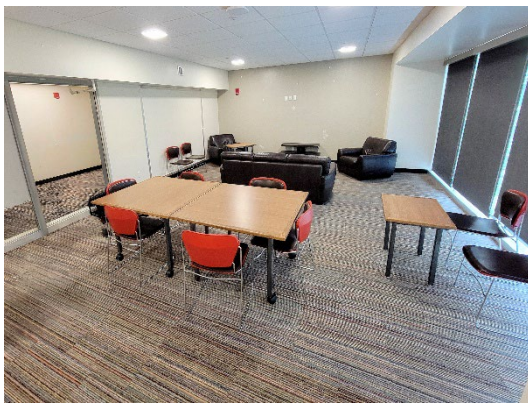
♦ GAMEPLAY ♦

CAMPAIGN SESSIONS

The core of the event will consist of **six two-hour campaign sessions** hosted by our 14 Game Masters this year. A slight change this year compared to previous events is that our GMs will each be hosting three sessions over the weekend rather than just two previously.

TABLE LOCATIONS

Tables 1 & 2 will be located in the Dens on the Third Floor of the building while **Tables 3-7** will be located in Study Rooms on the Ground Floor.



CAMPAIGN RESTRICTIONS

While the sky is the limit for campaign narratives, the format includes a few restrictions to keep sessions organized. First, all character preparation, story explanation, and rules introductions must be included **within the two-hour window** of the campaign. That means Game Masters cannot ask Players to write their characters, read exposition, or do any other prep work ahead of your scheduled session. In addition, the length of each campaign is limited to **exactly two hours** (or less if you finish early). That means each session has a hard stop at 120 minutes - *all pencils and dice down on the table once time is up.*

FOR PLAYERS

We recommend you come prepared to each session with a set of dice, writing utensil and notepad. Any additional materials will be provided to you by your GM.

FOR GAME MASTERS

As always, your campaign is **whatever you want it to be**. If you're looking for additional resources, we will have a wide selection of minis, maps, terrain, and tokens available for use during the event. If there is anything in particular you are looking for or if there are particular items you would like set aside, feel free to let Austin know and he'd be happy to help.

♦ SCORING ♦

A core component of Osiris events is providing feedback to both Game Masters and Players after each session in the form of **Score Cards**. Located at each table will be an envelope pertaining to the given session. At the end of each campaign, participants are to open the envelope and complete the score cards inside. Each player will fill out a score card for their GM while the GM fills out a score card for each player. Be sure that all score cards are then promptly completed and returned to the admin team.

For **Game Masters**, their campaigns are scored on 1-5 scale by Players on the attributes of **Story** (*how compelling and complete the narrative of the campaign was*), **Creativity** (*how unique and inventive the campaign was*), **Scene Building** (*how well the GM created immersive environments*), **Mechanics** (*how enjoyable and unique the gameplay elements of the campaign were*), and **Enjoyment** (*how much fun you had overall during the campaign*).

Meanwhile, **Players** are also graded by the Game Masters based on a 1-5 scale based on the quality of their **Roleplaying** (*how well the player portrayed their character*), **Immersion** (*how well the player adapted to the campaign*), **Attention** (*how well the player concentrated on the campaign*), **Cooperation** (*how well the player acted to achieve their goals*), and **Enjoyment** (*how much fun was it to have the player at the table*).

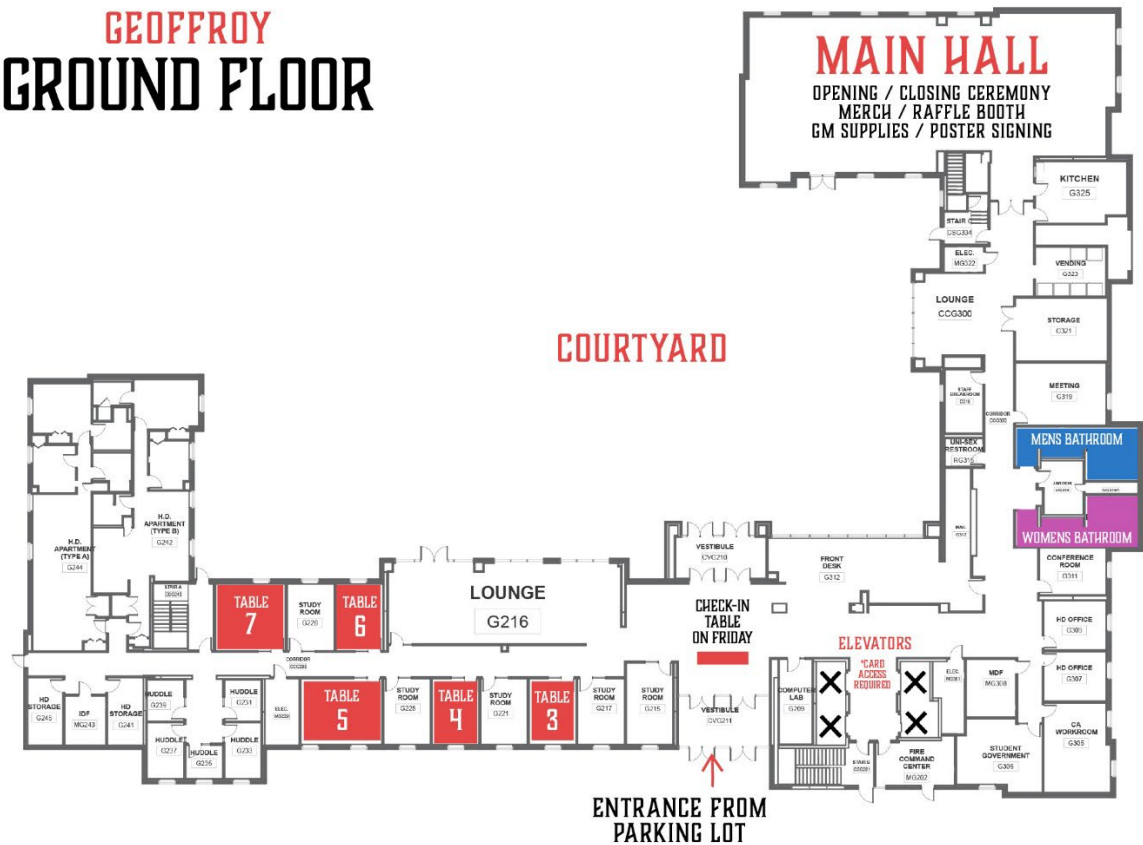

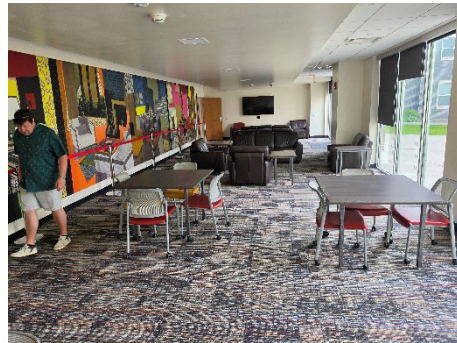


♦ ON-SITE AMENITIES ♦

Located on the ground floor, this large space will act as the primary event HQ – including activity space, the raffle / merch areas, ceremony space & much more!



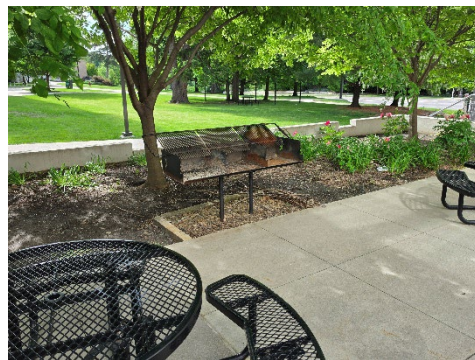
LOUNGE AREAS
